1. Summary of brainstorming session on "Tools for management and quality assurance"

A brainstorming session and follow-up discussions among the participants resulted in the following recommendations for ensuring high quality of the project / product / service:

- Research on the needs of the target groups (questionnaires, online survey, interviews, face-to-face meetings, etc.)
- Testing / Piloting activities with the involvement of the target groups
- Feedback from end-users and corrections
- Individual approach / tailoring the language product to the end-users' specific needs
- Measuring the results / Qualitative and quantitative indicators
- External evaluation / Involving external expert who is familiar with the specific environment
- Research on good practices and solutions for addressing the identified needs
- Assuring sustainability of the interest after the end of the funding period
- Measuring the impact and applying long-term impact targets and instruments
