

Evaluation Report

At the end of the workshop on 21 February 2014 the participants were encouraged to provide feedback on the activities by completing a questionnaire. The information presented in the 12 completed questionnaires is summarized below:

General feed-back on the workshop:

- The structure of the workshop programme was described as suitable by all 12 respondents.
- The workshop's content was perceived as interesting by all 12 respondents.
- Regarding the workshop's content, most respondents considered it was very well developed
- All respondents considered the workshop was consistent with their expectations.
- The balance between theory and practice was described as very suitable by all 12 respondents.
- All respondents said the methodologies used were appropriate and the practical activities were useful.
- The skills of the presenters/ moderators were perceived as excellent.
- The interaction between experts/ moderators and participants, as well as between the workshop participants was considered to be stimulating.

Reasons for participating in the workshop

- Desire to become involved in research projects
- Wish to increase the chances of success of project applications
- Gaining a better understanding of quality standards in language projects
- Getting information about examples of good practice (ELL projects);
- Obtaining information about the European Language Label
- Acquiring new skills in terms of project design and project management;
- Establishing new contacts – networking;

Comments about the workshop:

The respondents made no negative comments on the workshop. The areas they really appreciated were:

- The workshop pleasant due to the organisers and participants attitude, work atmosphere, proven expertise of the specialist invited (i.e. the representative of the Romanian National Agency in charge of the ELL);
- The practical activities were well managed and interesting;
- The workshop was very constructive and it had a concrete outcome: ideas for a new project in adult education;
- Sharing ideas with the colleagues in Lithuania;
- The brainstorming session was stimulating;

- The workshop has highlighted the need for one or more follow up sessions to finalise the project proposal and identify new project ideas;
- The workshop was interesting, well organised and well managed
- The professional profile of organizers and participants.
