



Problem identified	Proposed solution
Risk of decrease of quality standards in education	 To stress the link between language and culture To promote interculturalism To use innovative and reliable methods which guarantee quality standards to a huge potential of end users To promote integration between theory and practice
Need to enhance the links with the labour market at national/European level	 To consider languages as a qualifying element for European citizenship and for employment To see Europe as an opportunity and mobility as an attitude To engage stakeholders at all levels To do lobbying at political level



Educational programs are not innovation oriented	To insert innovative tools in the existing programs


