Context:

The aim of FIESTA is to develop:

(1) A multi-disciplinary learning approach for professionals in education, health and social services in order to facilitate the additional learning and support requirements of children with special needs during periods of transition

(2) Tools and resources for pupils and parents to facilitate successful transition and inclusive education.

This conference will use a participative/holistic approach to harness inclusive methods during transition for children with special educational needs. It will promote collaborative working during periods of transition for all stakeholders involved - e.g. pupils with special educational needs, parents/families, educators, health professionals, social workers, NGOs.

Conference Objectives:

The conference will focus on the outcomes of the FIESTA network developed in order to facilitate children with special educational needs during periods of transition. It will be of particular interest to: **Teachers**, **Principals**, **Parents Educational psychologists**, **Guidance counsellors**, **Social support staff**, **Researchers**, and **Health Professionals**.
