The Improvement Plan should be structured as follows:

1) Authors of the Plan

Representatives of organisations active in the field of adult education and vocational education and training. 4 people took part in the work group which had the task to improve a non-successful language initiative

2) Description of the Initiative

Name of the initiative: “Healthcare for Everybody”

Goals:

- Help migrants improve their knowledge about health matters in Bulgaria
- Make health care more accessible for migrants and improve their integration
- Improving the language skills of immigrants related to healthcare matters
- Improving the communication between immigrants and healthcare providers

3) Presentation of the Coordinator of the Initiative

Centre for Learning and Cultural Bonding - NGO

4) Improvement Plan

- The proposal should include partners with experience in the work with migrants
- Associated partners representing migrant organisations and organisations for integration should be attracted and involved in the project activities
- Healthcare providers and experts in the field should be also involved in the project
- Argumentation of the problem with immigrants not receiving quality healthcare services as a result of the language barrier
- Quality indicators have to be foreseen
- Perform a research of the needs of the target groups in advance

- There have to be concrete results, clearly described and linked to addressing the needs of the target groups

5) Strategy to submit the project to the ELL

- Analysis of the project potential for its successful submission in the framework of the ELL
- Analysis of the consistency of the project as in the Improvement Plan with the ELL European
 - Make clear description of the problem and the project and refer it to the award criteria for ELL
 - Stress the importance of the issue on European level and describe how the project and the proposed results will have a long-term impact on the target groups and how they can be transferred to other European countries
 - Develop and implement your project taking into consideration the award criteria for ELL
