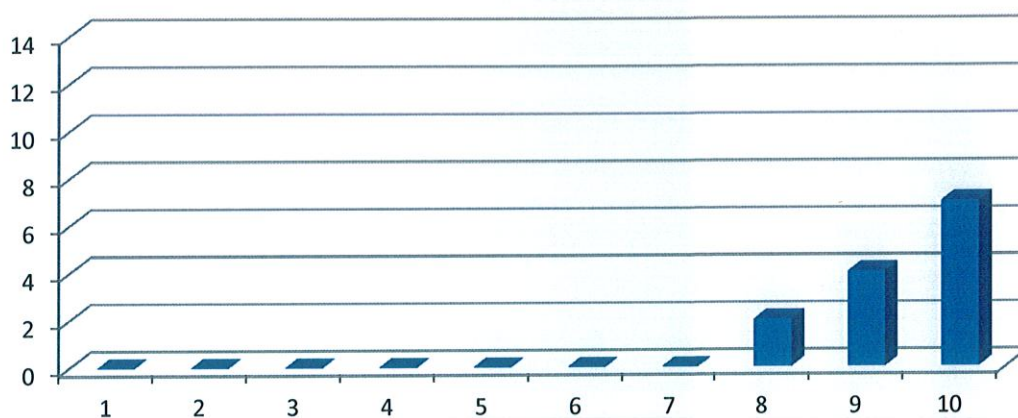


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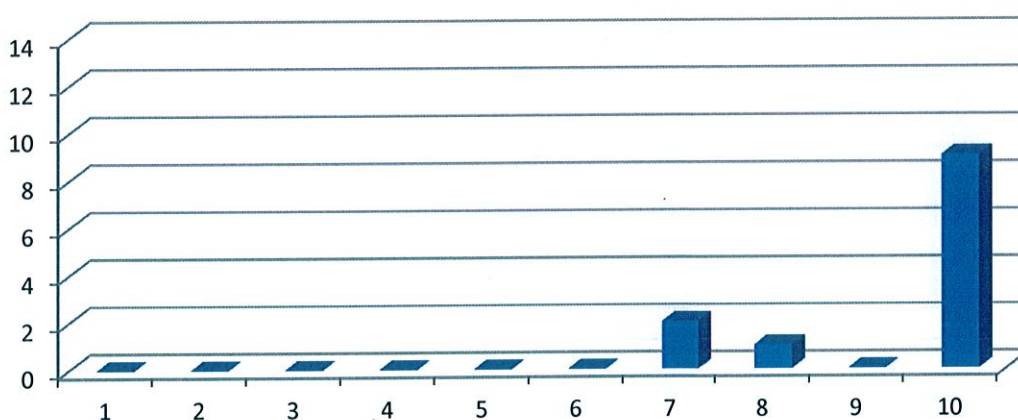
Were the stated objectives of the workshop achieved?

Was the workshop consistent with your expectations?

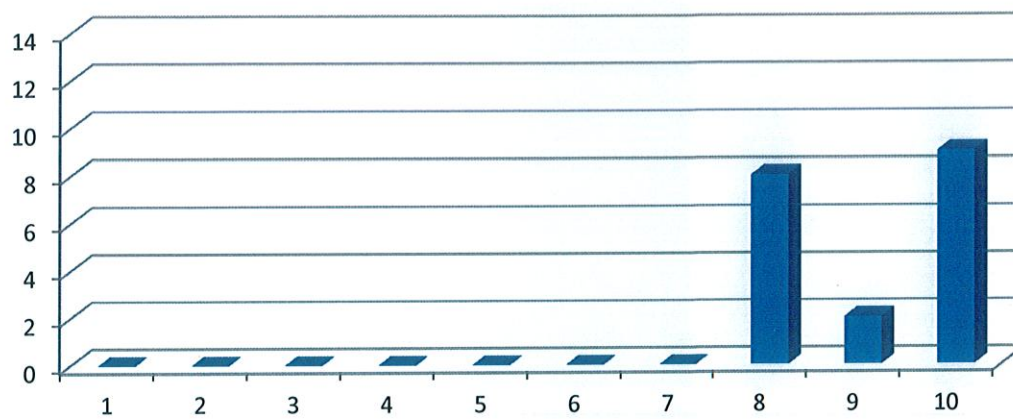

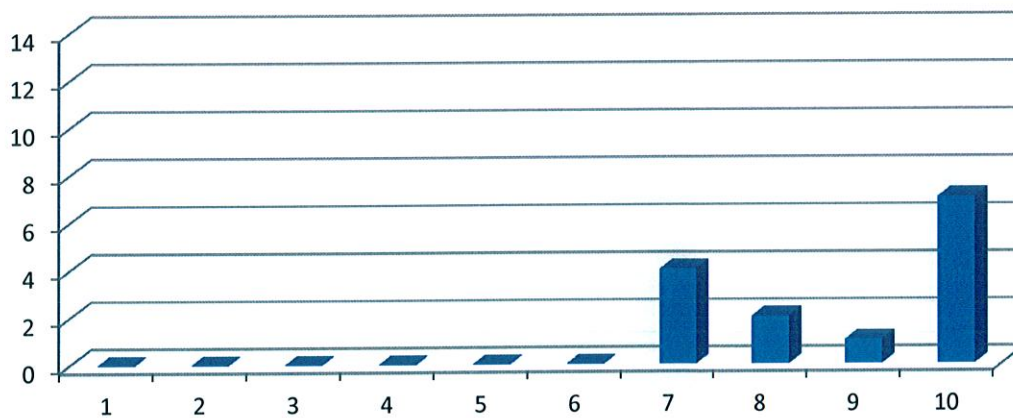
The balance between theory and practice was...

The methodologies used were...

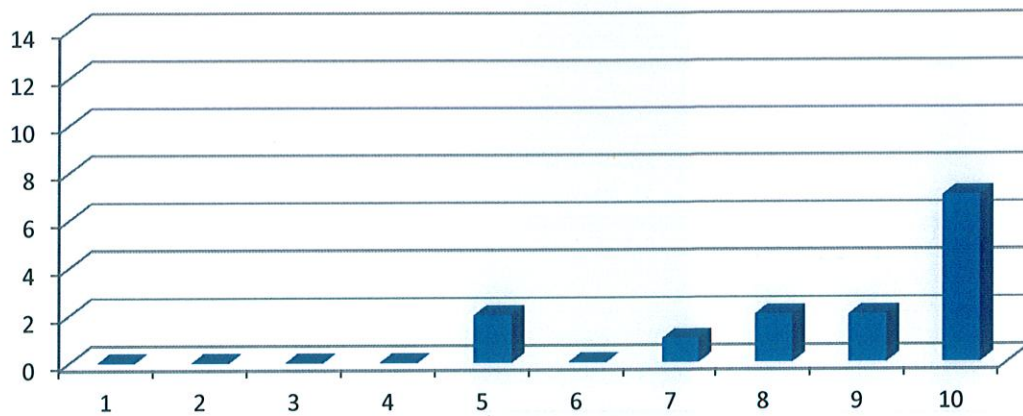

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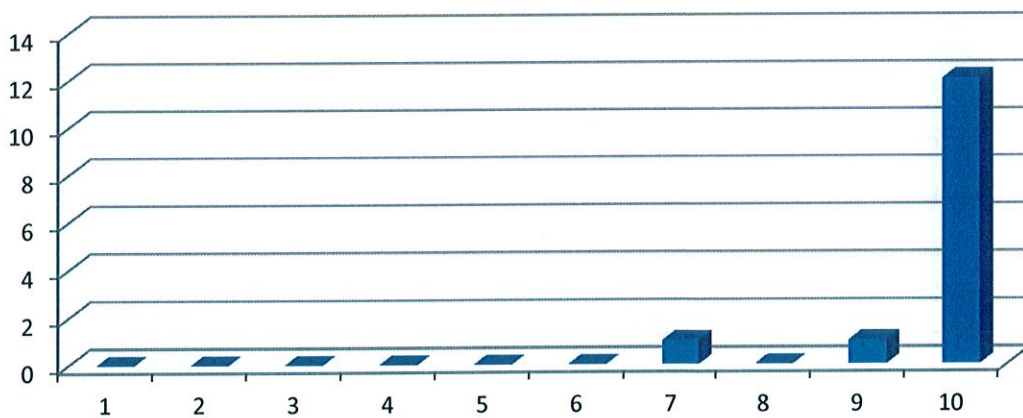
The practical activities organized were...

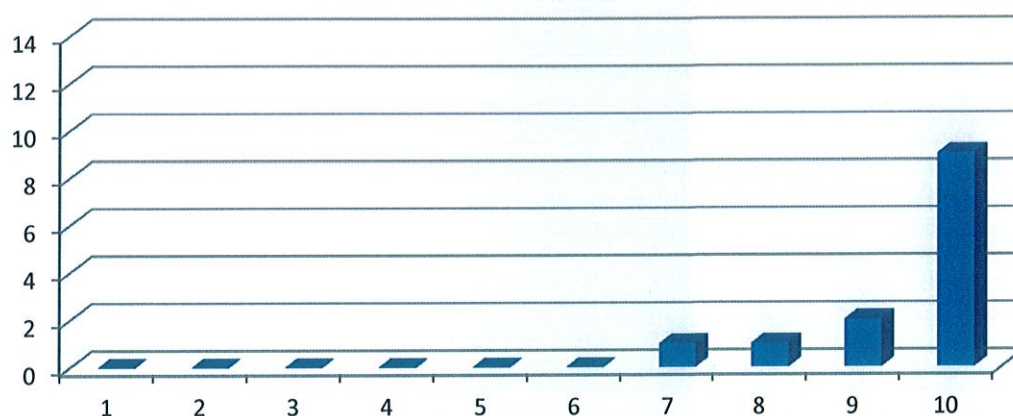


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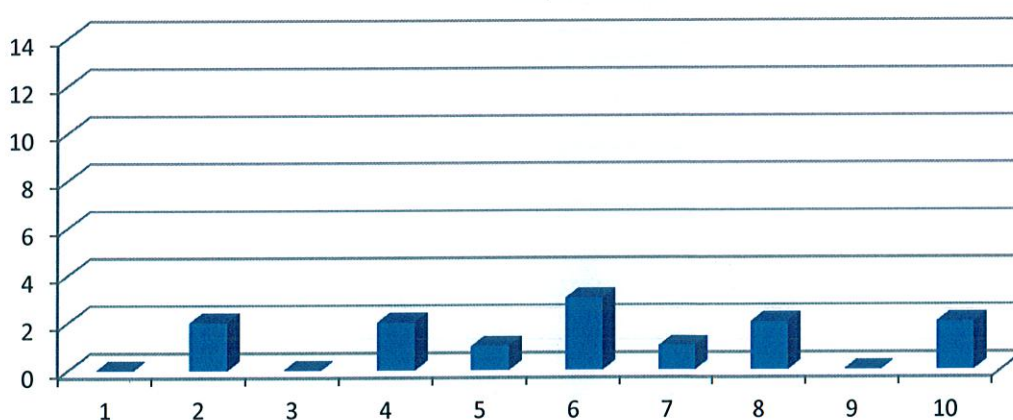
Interaction among participants was...

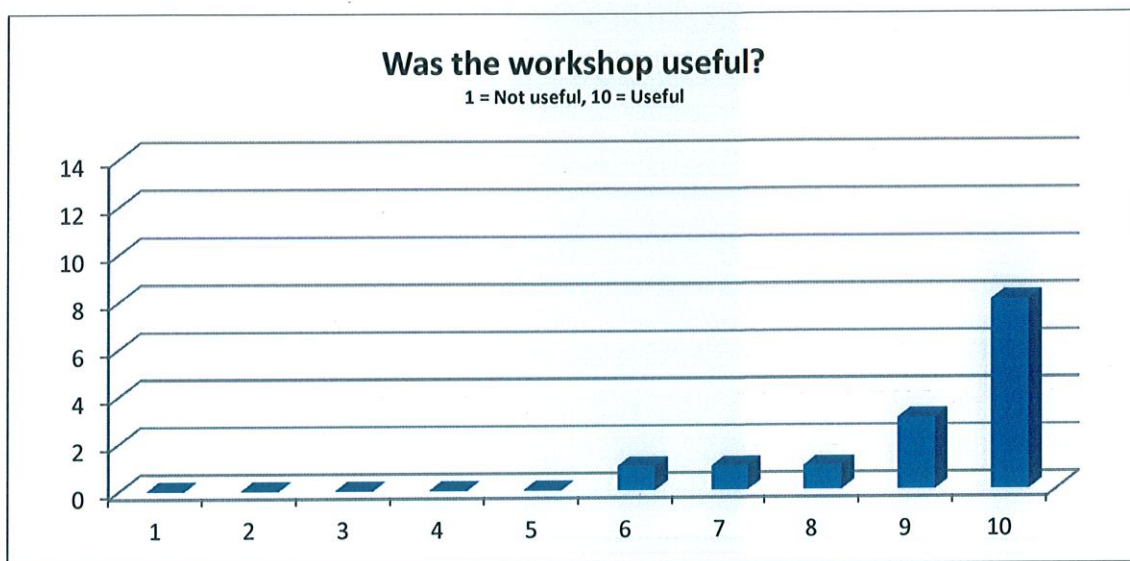
Was the transnational online meeting beneficial?
