• 13.15 Today's program and information about the Nellip-project

Bo Lundahl from Teacher training welcomes students. He introduces Anna Lagnevik and Lieselotte Wengberg referring to the thematic work the students just have started explaining how they can relate this afternoon's program to this work. Coordinators present today's program and show slides shortly informing about the ELL in Europe and in Sweden followed by an introduction of the Nellip project as well as a short guiding of the Nellip portal.

A majority of the students work with a project plan for their thematic work. Some study projects from the portal and evaluate, find some improvement issues and comment on them.

Some groups shortly present their project plan to the whole group. Coordinators sum up the afternoon hoping that the Nellip portal, the Nellip guidelines and today's tasks will be of use in their future work as a teacher.
