The deliverables that are being developed include:

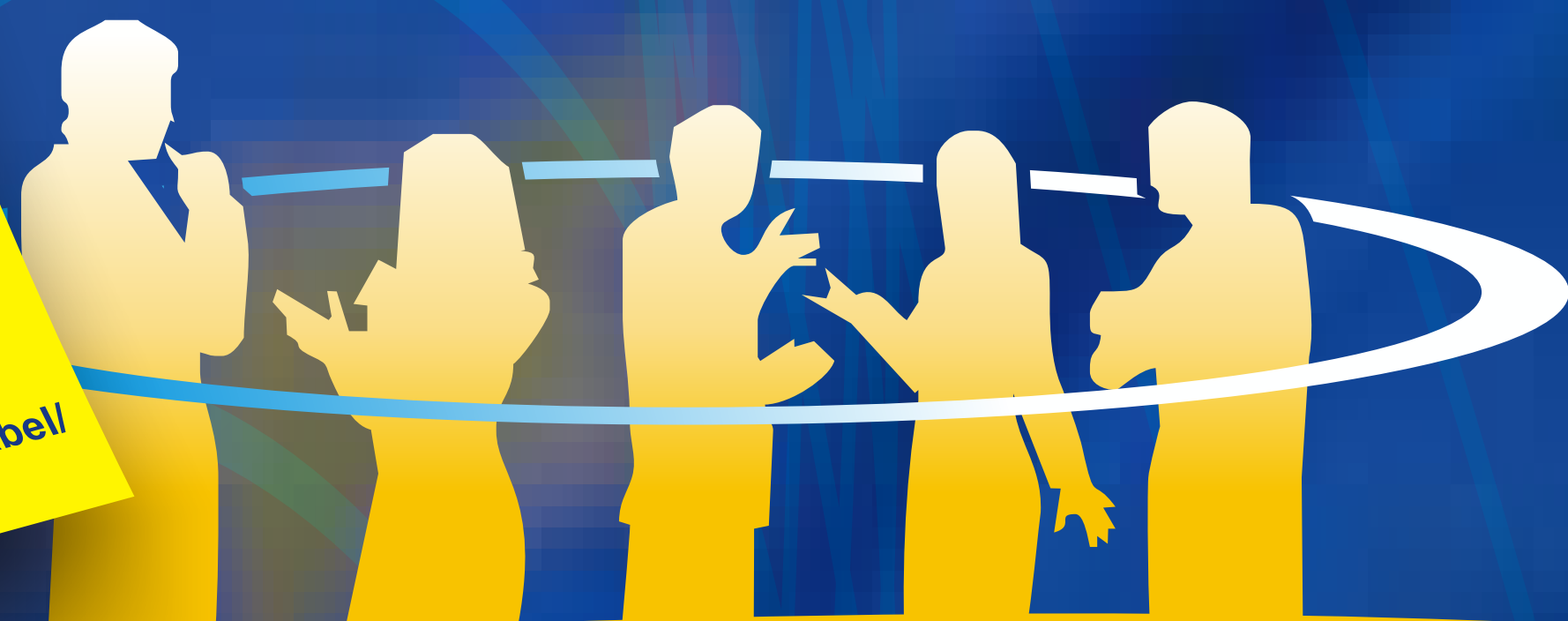
- **Case studies** and examples of good practice in language learning

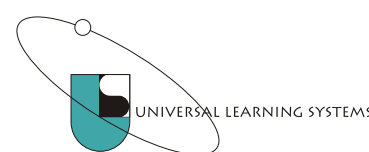
